WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Water Code § 49.004, the Board is authorized to establish reasonable civil penalties for breach of its rules and regulations.

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HAYS COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The schedule of civil penalties attached hereto as **Exhibit "A**" (the "Penalty Schedule") is hereby adopted;
- 2. All capitalized terms and phrases defined in the District's rules and regulations and used in this Resolution and the Penalty Schedule shall have the meaning ascribed to them under the District's rules and regulations;
- 3. The Penalty Schedule shall become effective immediately upon execution of this Order (the "Effective Date");
- 4. Civil penalties for Violations of District rules and regulations that are not set forth in the Penalty Schedule shall be determined by the Board.
- 5. The previous schedule of civil penalties adopted by the District on November 12, 2020, shall be of no force and effect with respect to any event occurring on or after the Effective Date, and are hereby rescinded as of the Effective Date;
- 6. If any provision, section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Order, or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void or invalid (or for any reason unenforceable), the validity of the remaining portions of this Order or the application to such other persons or sets of circumstances shall not be affected thereby, it being the intent of the Board in adopting this Order, that no portion hereof or provision contained herein shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any unconstitutionality or invalidity of any other portion or provision; and
- 7. The Secretary of the Board is hereby directed to file a copy of this Order in the principle office of the District. This Order shall be and remain in full force and affect from and after the date of filing.
